



Hungary is one of the very few countries where folk-dancing is on an incredibly high artistic level. Our authentic folk-dance shows take place in the Duna Palota and the Budai Vigadó, performed by three of the best professional Hungarian folk ensembles.

Our venues take place in the beautiful baroque [Danube Palace](#) and the secession style Budai Vigadó, two theatres in a central downtown location.

Every concert starts at 20:00 consisting of two 40-45 minutes long parts with an intermission in between.
